At East Washington Elementary, the Minds in Motion room is changing lives in ways that are both powerful and deeply personal. Because of you, students with physical challenges are experiencing new opportunities to move, participate, and enjoy being kids.

This year, your support helped purchase a rocker balance beam and other specialized equipment to expand the room's possibilities. While the equipment itself is important, what it makes possible is even more meaningful.

One young student, who uses a wheelchair and has very limited movement, reached a milestone that her family and school staff will never forget. For the first time, she was able to sit up independently at school.



When she is gently lifted from her wheelchair and given the opportunity to explore movement in the Minds in Motion room, something remarkable happens. Her face lights up. She giggles. She smiles. In those precious moments, you can see the joy and freedom she feels.

Another student, a little boy with significant motor delays, has also found something special in this space. Many childhood experiences, including playing on a traditional playground, can be difficult for him to access. But in the Minds in Motion room, he is included.

Most importantly, he has found his voice.

The excited squeals that fill the room during his time there are more than sounds. They are signs that he feels comfortable and connected. They remind everyone around him that every child deserves the chance to participate and feel included.



Because of you, these students are building strength, increasing endurance, and developing important physical skills. But the impact goes far beyond therapy goals and progress reports.

You are helping children experience success. You are helping them build confidence. You are giving them opportunities they might not otherwise have.

This fall, the little girl will begin second grade, and the little boy will attend preschool. As East Washington Elementary prepares to welcome them and many other students back to school, the Minds in Motion room will continue to be a place where children can grow and thrive.

The lives being changed in the Minds in Motion room may not always make headlines. They happen quietly, one smile or one milestone at a time.
