Leo attended Hanover College for one year and then transferred to Purdue University where he earned a degree in Pharmacy. He graduated from Purdue with the highest distinction. After graduation, Leo served in the military as a corporal working in a pharmacy. Upon completion of his military service, Leo went back to school to obtain his Masters of Science degree in Chemistry in 1957 from the University of Washington. He then earned a PhD in Philosophy in 1961, also from the University of Washington.

After school, Leo set his sights on the world. He lived in several states, including Alaska, where, according to Leo, it "got to be twenty below and the snow was so fine you could inhale it into your lungs." He also lived in Australia, while he was a professor at the University in Sydney. He travelled the world and chronicled his adventures in a travel log.

Professionally, Leo also left his mark on the world. He worked as a pharmacist in Washington and Michigan, but

his biggest accomplishment was working on the design team for UpJohn that created the coating for Motrin.

Leo did not limit his quest for knowledge to academia. He was also a highly accomplished and prolific artist. He played the trombone in a dance band, composed music, wrote poetry, penned pearls of wisdom, carved wood statuettes, and painted numerous paintings.

After retiring in 1981, Leo decided to make Salem, Indiana his home. He built a house and lived there for over 30 years.

If Leo's story ended here all would agree that he certainly made his mark on the world. However, his story does not end here. In 2019, Leo donated to the Washington County Community Foundation to create the Dr. Leo W. Brown Touch Tomorrow Fund. This fund will give back to Washington County in a multitude of ways. More importantly, Leo's legacy will live on forever. Brilliant!

Loving, caring, compassionate, thoughtful, strong..... all words that leap to mind when describing Lucille McIntosh Rawlings. Her son, Keith, probably summed it up best by saying, "She was one helluva woman."

Lucille was born January 10, 1901. She married Theodore Rawlings on June 11, 1921. Lucille and Theodore had three sons.

Life was difficult for Lucille, raising three boys alone after her husband died in 1938. Her father, Joseph, was very involved, helping her to raise three very active boys. "We never had much cash," recalled Keith, "but we managed. We raised most of what we ate. We knew Mom was doing the best she could for us." Lucille worked hard to provide for her family. She worked at the Hardinsburg Bank for several years and eventually became a teacher in Fredericksburg. She taught elementary students, primarily third and fourth graders, for several years.

Because of Lucille's caring, loving nature, her son, Dale Rawlings, left his estate to establish the Lucille McIntosh Rawlings Scholarship Fund, to help future generations of Washington County students pursue a degree in Education. Lucille's impact as an educator will now go on forever.


