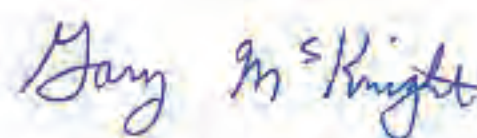

Founding Board Members Cook Up a

When a small group of community-minded people met in 1993 to discuss the formation of a Community those people, Carmelita Jean and Jean Wilson, knew they were cooking up something great for Washington

Unfortunately, our community lost these two great women in 2021,

Carmelita grew up in the southern portion of Washington County, the only child of farmers. But, according to her, “me and the cat got along just fine.” In school, she enjoyed math and put that to use into adulthood by obtaining her accounting certificate from Spencerian Business School and then working at Hannah Motors Oldsmobile in Louisville. After a few years of working, Carmelita was able to stop working full-time to become a housewife and an active community member. She and her love, Burl, married in October of 1959 and then welcomed their daughters, Jennifer and Allison, several years later.

She always enjoyed being home to teach the girls and volunteer in the community while Burl farmed and worked at the BF Goodrich factory in Salem. Carmelita loved to cook and share a meal so she started a catering company while home which eventually turned into owning her own restaurant (and publishing cookbooks!) later in life. Burl and Carmelita are notorious for hard work and community involvement.

Carmelita said her class motto “Good, better, best – never settle until your good is better and your better is best” always stuck with her in whatever she did.

Her spirit of making her better best was with community service – teaching servant leadership through Awareness Washington County, heading up American Cancer drives, helping to start the Community Foundation, and so many other community building and improvement activities that no one ever knew she was involved with. She once remarked, “I owe it to the people in the community for all they have allowed me to be involved in.”

Those who knew Carmelita know how important her faith was to her. She knew that she was going to live her best life and knew she was going to make it to heaven after she was baptized. She always tried to pass those beliefs along to others as well.



Carmelita's Mother's Recipe

2 c. warm water
1 pkg. (2 ½ tsp.) yeast
3 T. sugar

Whisk these ingredients together in a mixing bowl.

Then add:

2 T. melted shortening or vegetable oil

Whisk again and wait 10 to 15 minutes to make sure the yeast is working.

Then add:

3 ½ c. flour – you will most likely need to gradually add more flour to reach the right texture.

1 ½ tsp. salt

Fold using the heel of your hand. Lift dough and put 3-4 T. oil in the mixing bowl. Turn dough to coat. Let rise 1 hour. The dough can rise and fall at this stage.

Pinch off dough and make rolls. Place in sprayed baking pan. Let rise in pan for

45 minutes. The dough cannot fall at this stage.

Bake at 400 degrees for 12-15 minutes.

Carmelita loved Washington County, wanted to see it grow, wanted our children to flourish and be confident, which is why she and Burl left a lasting Legacy through the Washington County Community Foundation because it was home. They set up several funds in order to give back. Because of their generosity, many causes will be forever blessed – Riley's Place, The Women's Fund, Awareness Washington County, student scholarships, and other nonprofits through the Burl and Carmelita Jean Touch Tomorrow Fund.

Jean Wilson came into this world on May 16, 1930 in Pekin, the second child of 12 children. All her life, she was used to taking care of others and that included Washington County.

After graduating from high school in 1949, she married Donovan a few short months later and then studied under Cornelius Hubbach with The Design Firm of Hubbach Interiors in Louisville. In 1969, Jean opened her own interior design firm in Salem, The Designers Studio, establishing herself as a fierce businesswoman and community advocate. She was known for her expertise in interior design throughout Southern Indiana and Louisville, even teaching classes at Indiana University Southeast.

Jean loved finding and creating beauty in all around her and that included improving the community in which she lived and worked. She was active in many organizations and was instrumental in founding the Friend of the Salem Public Library, a member of the Urban Beautification Committee and was even a consultant and designer for the City of Salem Town Hall as well as the Senior Citizens Center and Community Learning Center.

One of Jean's biggest endeavors was as a member of the founding Board of Directors of the Foundation – establishing a legacy that would last forever. In fact, one of the first funds in the Foundation was established by her – The Whiskey Wilson Humane Society Fund. Jean believed that “it was important for a community to take care of its animals, as well as its people.” She knew that with the fund for Whiskey, the Humane Society would benefit forever and she wanted to show them her appreciation for them taking such good care of their pet, Whiskey, before she and Donovan adopted him. When establishing the fund, Jean said, “It is gratifying to know that this fund is permanent and will always be available to help other animals in Washington County.”

Jean's legacy is one of leaving a footprint of creativity and beauty behind her and that meant not only designing and influencing others by teaching them the art of interior design, but by also influencing them by being a leader, a volunteer, a role model, an advocate for Washington County and its residents-human and animal.

Jean Wilson's Baked Chicken Salad

3 c. cubed chicken (6 chicken breasts)
1 c. slivered almonds
1 c. water chestnuts (drained and sliced)
1 small can chopped pimento
2 c. celery – chopped fine
1 t. salt
¼ t. pepper
1 T. lemon juice
1 can cream of chicken soup (do not dilute)
1 c. grated cheddar cheese
Topping – 1 c. crumbled French fried onions

Boil chicken and let cool. Cube. Then, combine all ingredients except onion topping. Bake at 325 for 15 minutes. Sprinkle fried onions on top and then bake for an additional 30 minutes.
