

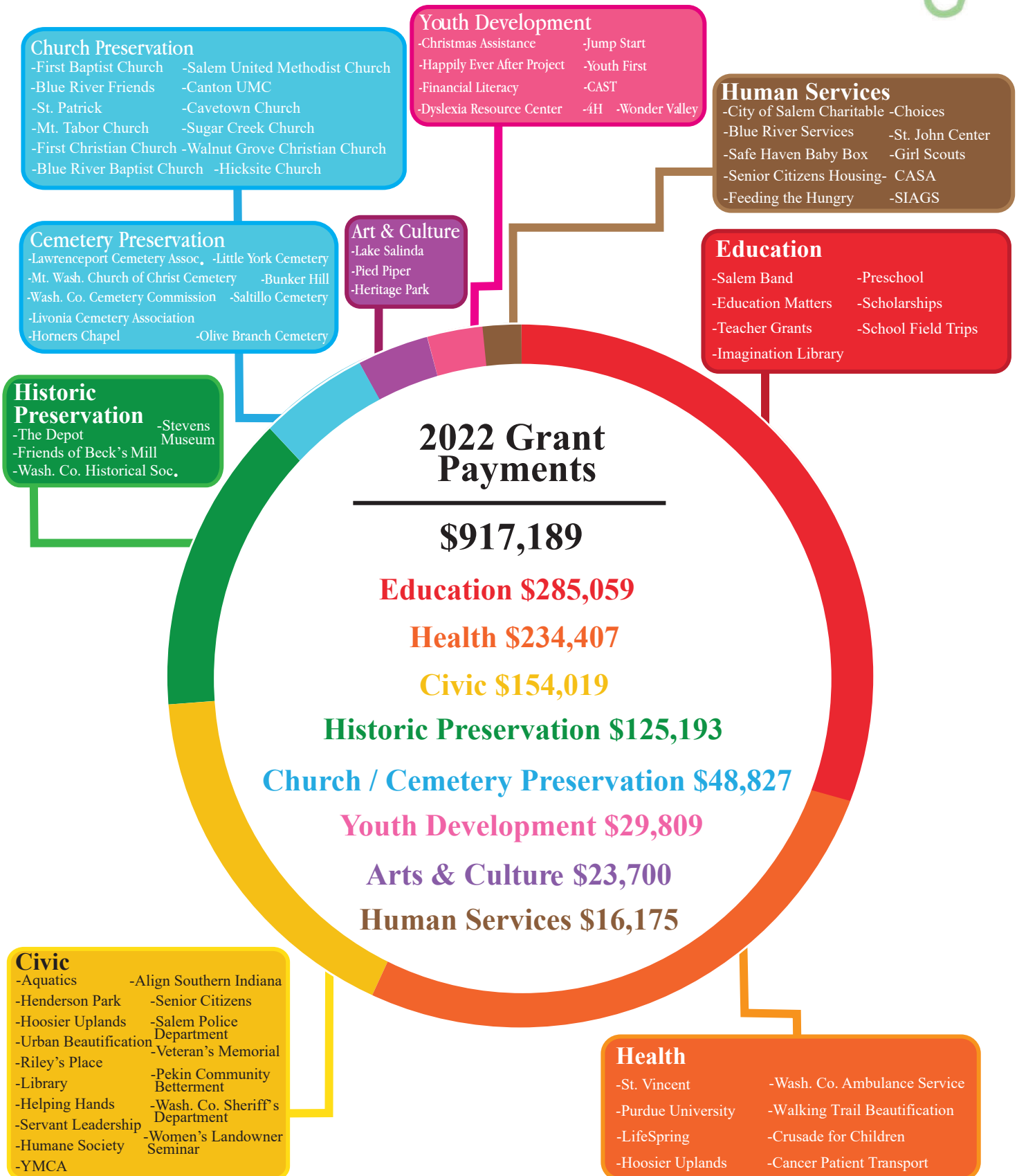

Jack Mahuron...

His Legacy will live on.

Gen. Douglas MacArthur stated, "Old soldiers never die, they just fade away" This may be true for some soldiers, but it could not be further from the truth for Jack Mahuron.

Yes, Jack served in the active military and the National Guard for decades; he definitely was a soldier; but he will never fade away. Jack's role in helping to establish the Washington County Community Foundation, along with several other local nonprofits, will ensure his Legacy will live on forever.

Jack served as the first Executive Director of the Washington County Community Foundation from 1993-2001. For nine years he was the Face of the Foundation, helping to educate the community of what Foundations do and the impact they can have. He did so much to get the Foundation started, all on a volunteer basis.

As you can imagine, the early years of the Foundation were challenging... literally. The Lilly Endowment offered a series of GIFT Challenge Grants to all Indiana community foundations. Jack and all the early board members worked tirelessly and successfully met each and every challenge grant.

Helping to establish the Washington County Community Foundation is just one of Jack's accomplishments. He was also involved in the building and financing of the John Hay Center and Stevens Memorial Museum and the restoration and financing of Beck's Mill. Jack was the chairman of the full-year celebration of the City of Salem Sesquicentennial in 1964, which was the longest and biggest celebration in Salem's history. He also chaired the Bicentennial Celebration in 1976. Jack served 40 years as a volunteer fireman and was an active 80-year member of the First Christian Church, Salem. His volunteer interests also included the field of education by being a former advisory board member of Indiana University Southeast and the Paul W. Ogle Cultural & Community Center.

Jack has left his mark all over this county. Even though he has left us, he will continue to impact our community through the funds he and his wife, Carol, set up in our Foundation. They will help people in our community forever. Their impact will only grow.

Yes, old soldiers may fade away, but Jack Mahuron will live on forever.

Washington County Youth Foundation Update

Thanks to you, the 2022-2023 school year was one of change, growth, and learning in the Washington County Youth Foundation. After a couple of years of the Youth Foundation struggling with COVID restrictions and not being able to go out and volunteer, the group was ready for a revamp.

The school year started with nine students all from Salem High School. By the end of the year, in April, the group had 16 students with all three county schools and homeschool represented. This was the first time the group offered mid-year recruitment. The students did a great job promoting the Youth Foundation and gaining wonderful new members.

This year, the Youth Foundation added a new element, their Passion Project. The project they chose this year was “Stop Stress in Schools”. The group focused on sharing the new “988” hotline for mental health and suicide prevention. Students went to their local middle schools and sat at lunches sharing flyers with the resources on them. Flyers were also put around town at Cheddar Depot, the Salem Public Library, and 4-H Extension Office so other students or family members could see them, as this is not just a problem within young kids but also adults. “In 2020 alone, the U.S. had one death by suicide about every 11 minutes—and for people aged 10-34 years, suicide is a leading cause of death. There is hope. The 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline is a national network of more than 200 crisis centers that helps thousands of people overcome crisis situations every day” (988 suicide and Crisis Lifeline). The students did a great job at recognizing a problem in our county and working to find a solution. The 988 hotline for mental health and suicide prevention is for everyone at anytime. This is such a powerful resource that everyone should know about and be able to share with someone in time of need.

Overall, this new element helped each student look at our county and learn that they can find opportunities to make improvements. Students also worked on event planning, public speaking, and team building skills. Each year the Passion Project could be something different. It will be up to the current group at that time.

On top of planning their Passion Project the group did many philanthropic activities throughout the year. The students started off the year creating wind chimes with left over pieces from the Lake Salinda art installations. At Christmas they collected hygiene products, room décor, and fun personal items to take to a local nursing home for the residents to have Christmas presents. In the spring students worked hard on the Mini’s for Pennies fundraiser; raising money for the Happily Ever After Program. The fundraiser raised a total of \$3,049.11! Lastly, for our spring service day students donated old T-shirts and recycled them into dog toys and donated them to the Washington County Humane Society.

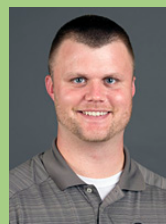
