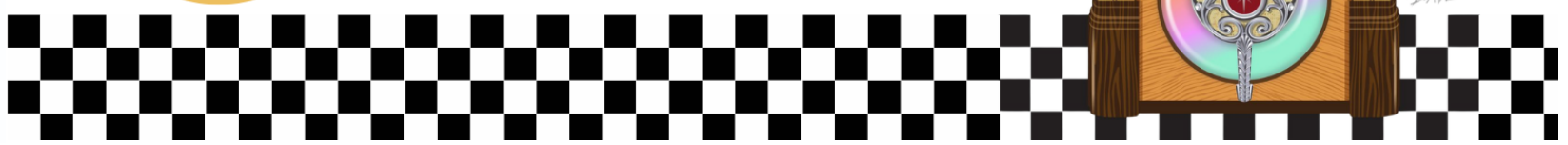

George and Joellen Meahl

A LIFE OF HARD WORK, KINDNESS, AND GIVING BACK



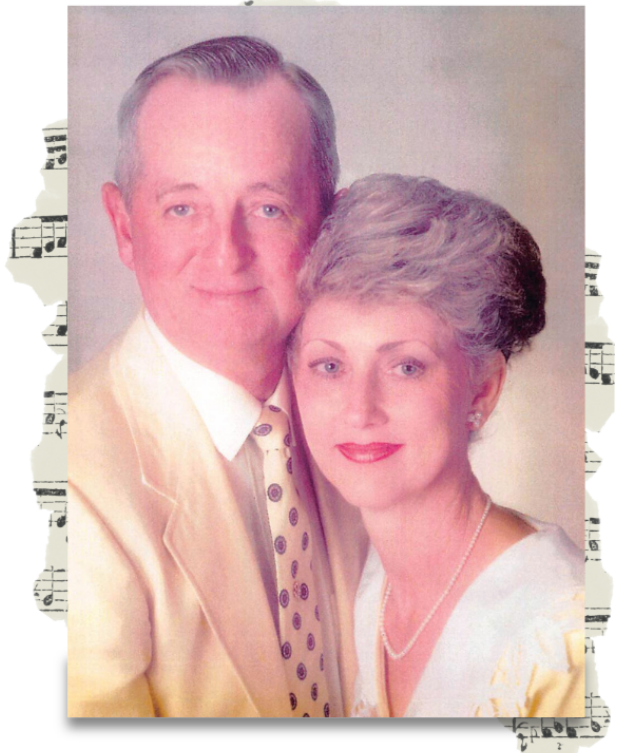
George Meahl was born in 1931 in Vallonia, Indiana, and grew up on a farm where he learned early the value of hard work and caring for the land. Farming was not just his livelihood — it was his joy. He loved growing fruit, especially apples, cherries, peaches, and melons, and took great pleasure in sharing his harvest with neighbors and friends.

George proudly served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War as a lineman, keeping communication lines running in dangerous conditions. Known as a calm, caring leader, he returned home to build a successful farming business and earned awards for conservation and stewardship. Yet what people remember most was his kindness — he never met a stranger, always kept his word, and faced challenges with a smile.

Joellen Churchman Meahl was born in 1940 and raised in Pekin, Indiana, by her devoted mother after losing her father at age three. From a young age, she worked hard at home and on the farm, helping with chores, gardening, and canning late into the night. She also loved music and dance, studying ballet along with piano, violin, and harp.

Encouraged by her mother to build a strong future, Joellen became a teacher. She earned degrees from Indiana University and spent over 40 years educating young children, more than three decades in first grade. Countless students learned to read, grow, and believe in themselves through her gentle guidance.

George and Joellen met as young adults and married in 1967 after a long courtship. Together they built a life rooted in faith, service, and community — George working the land while Joellen shaped young minds, each supporting the other.

Joellen was deeply involved in church life and was known for her beautiful flower displays that welcomed visitors to Salem. Their home overflowed with colorful blooms each season, a bright symbol of joy and hospitality.

In later years, George bravely battled cancer while Joellen lovingly cared for him until his passing in 2022. Joellen passed away in 2025. Though they had no children, their love for Washington County was profound.

To honor the community that meant so much to them, George and Joellen left their estate to the Washington County Community Foundation. Through their generosity, their legacy of hard work and kindness will continue to bless others for generations.

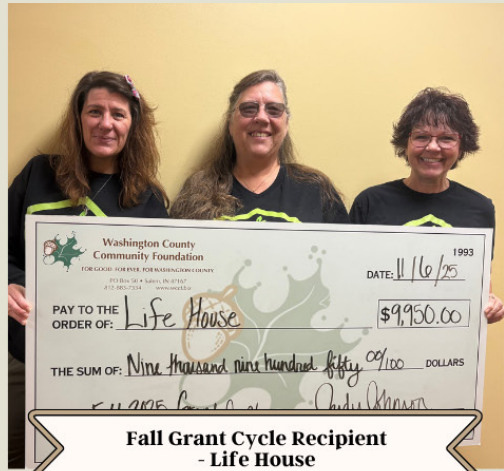
