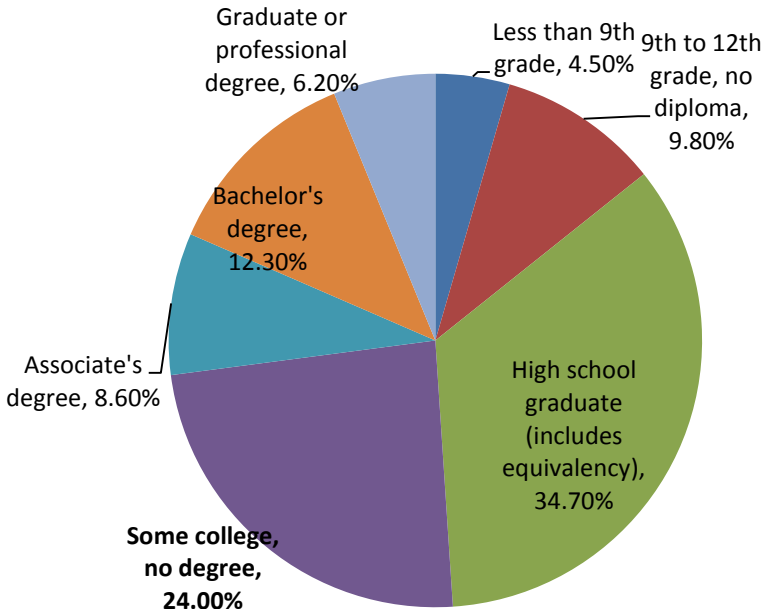
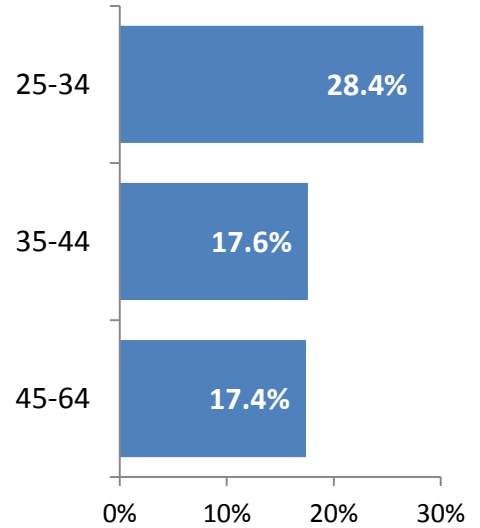

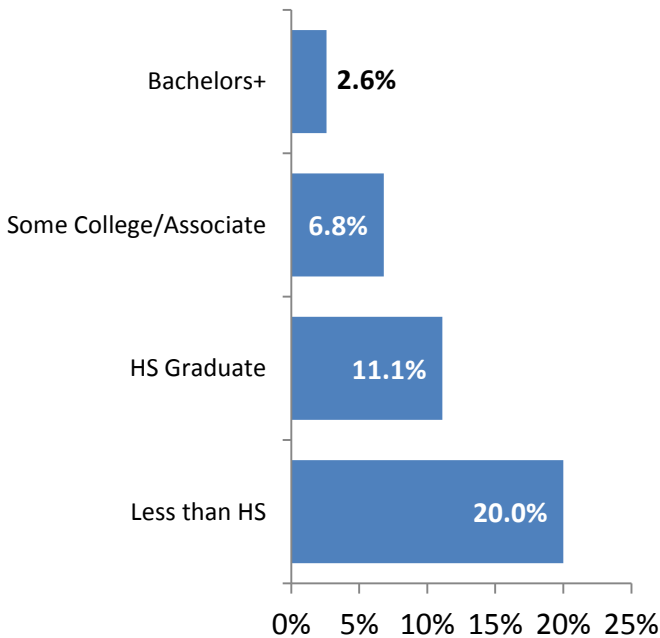
## Educational Attainment



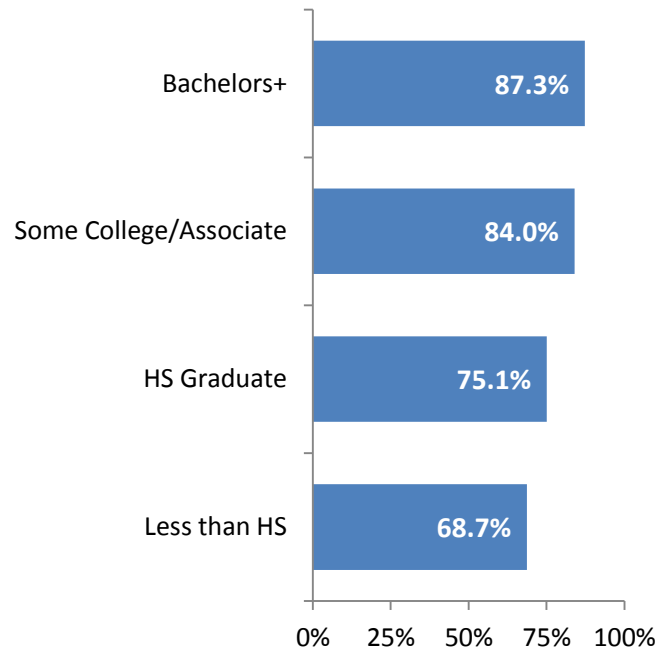
## Attainment by Age – Bachelor's +



## Unemployment by Educational Attainment



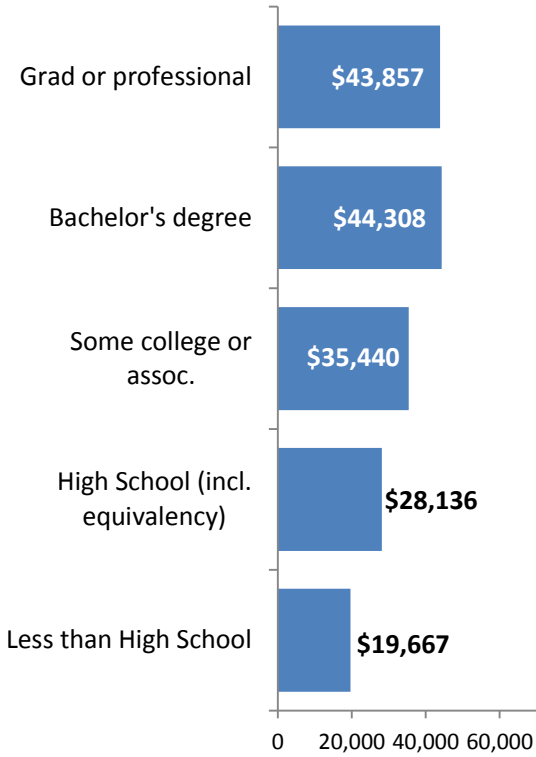
## Labor Force Participation by Attainment



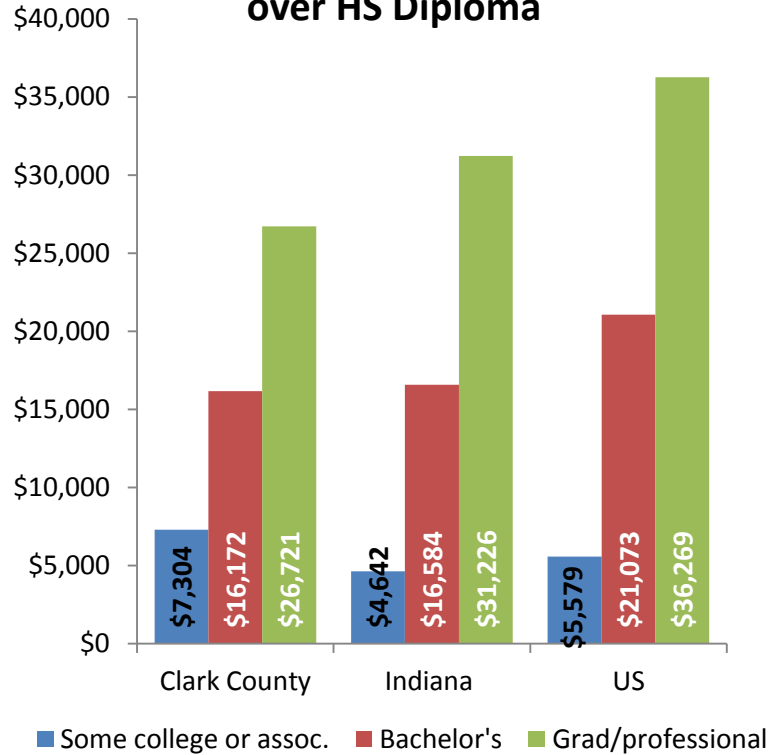

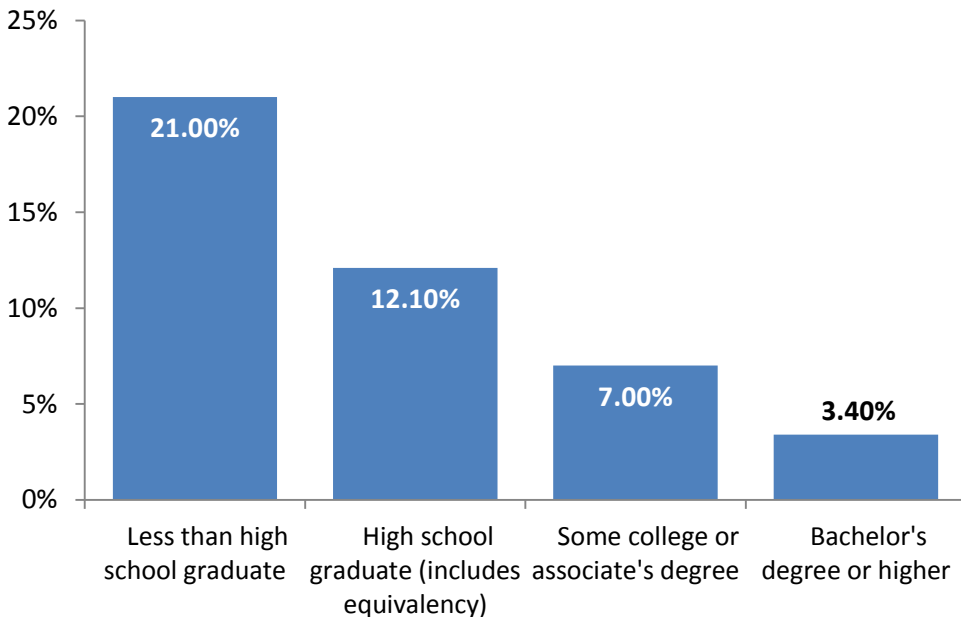
## Median Earnings by Educational Attainment
