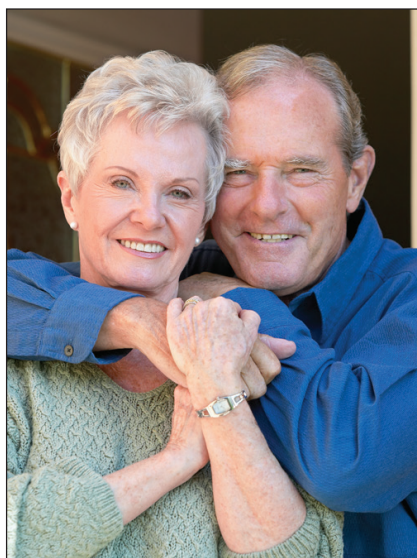

with the New
Tax Law



1. Make a larger gift to set up a Donor Advised Fund from which annual gifts can be made over 2 to 3 years.
2. Make an outright gift of appreciated assets and avoid Capital Gains Tax.
3. Gift from pre-tax assets by making an IRA Rollover gift, if you are 70% or older.
4. Fund a Charitable Gift Annuity or Charitable Remainder Trust, and receive income for life.

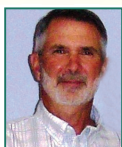
