Our donors are making a difference every day.

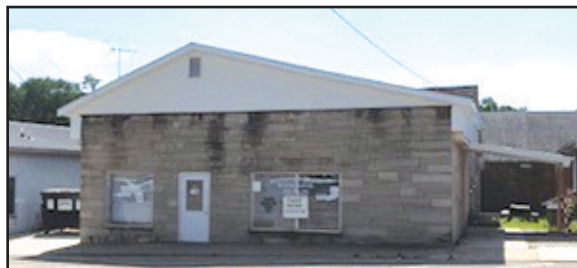
Very often the impact that you have in our community is subtle. Sometimes it is very obvious and visual. Here are two examples of construction projects you have accomplished:

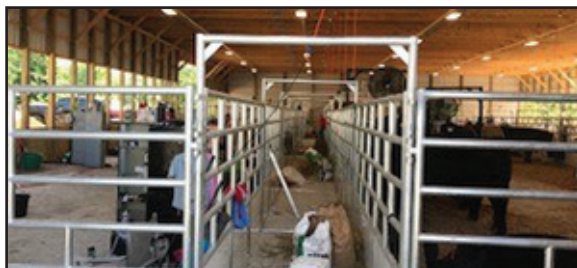
