Lives YOU Have Touched

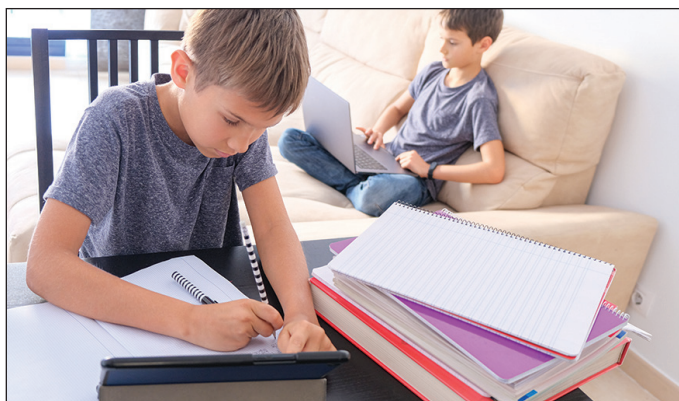
You are helping our local students learn from home.

Thanks to you, local students from all three school corporations are better prepared to “go virtual.”

These are difficult times for everyone. Our children and teachers are adapting to a temporary normal of their school day. For some students and parents that means opting into an on-line virtual academy for the entire school year. For others it means learning face-to-face when it is safe to do so, but also transitioning to a virtual classroom at any time. So far this school year, all three of our school systems have had to temporarily transition from face to face learning to virtual learning. This poses unique challenges, especially for families who do not have access to internet. That is where you stepped in.

Because of you, representatives from all three school corporations discussed common needs and the best ways to distribute a \$50,000 grant from the Foundation. After discussion, they all agreed that all three corporations could utilize the funds to provide technology for student use especially with more students opting for virtual learning and in case the schools would close for an indefinite time period. East Washington School Corporation, Salem Community Schools and West Washington School Corporation submitted a joint grant proposal for the following:

- West Washington will be applying their \$10,000 portion of the grant for Verizon Mi-Fi Hotspots.
- Salem will be applying their \$22,000 portion of the grant for Mi-Fi Hotspots, bus Wi-Fi to provide access to areas without internet

access, and access points at Bradie Shrum Elementary to make it 1:1 ready at the K-3 level.

- East Washington will be applying their \$18,000 appropriation for student Mi-Fi Hotspots to allow students accessibility to curriculum while off campus.

These grants are already having an impact. A family living in Posey Township with three children in elementary school has benefitted greatly from your generosity. High speed internet access at their house is not possible. According to the family, “The Wifi devices provided by West Washington with the funding from the Washington County Community Foundation have been amazing and filled a real need for our family. They work great, our kids’ devices connect easily and they have been able to complete all of their virtual school work. We couldn’t have done it without the internet access.”

Thank you for your generosity and helping to provide virtual learning opportunities for all our families.
