Thanks to donors like you, Mrs. Kiesler's East Washington Middle School 5th Grade Class was able to cook with the sun. This was a fun STEM activity during the 2022-2023 school year. Students worked together to make solar ovens. They used the ovens to make s'mores and quesadillas!

Once the temperature outside started to warm up in May, students began making the solar ovens. The class watched a short tutorial video and read various articles on tips and tricks of making a successful solar oven. Then they began working in groups, making the solar ovens with pizza boxes, construction paper, aluminum foil, plastic wrap, and masking tape.

Once all of the ovens were completed, the class made s'mores on the first day. The class checked the temperature of the ovens during the day and saw how the oven heated up throughout the day. They were able to eat the s'mores during science class. The following day, the class used them to make quesadillas.


Gift Your Stocks
