Because of you, these students are learning the importance of graduating high school and saving for emergencies.

Managing personal finances is tough. Ask anybody. Yet, having these skills is critical. This is where you come in. Because of you, members of our Youth Foundation were able to create their Money Masters program. This program focuses on teaching basic money management skills to elementary students. According to Devan Smith, President of the Washington County Youth Foundation, "This program teaches children the value of money and the importance of saving it, instead of spending it all."

Did you know that 40% of college seniors carry credit card debt from month to month? Failure to make the payments can impact their lives for years to come. Difficulties getting an

apartment, a cell phone, a car or even a job can result. So, the sooner kids can learn to manage their money, the better.

That is why the Washington County Youth Foundation created Money Masters. Currently, the Youth Foundation has supplied games to Third Grade teachers. "These games are easy for the kids to learn how to play and it usually only takes 10-15 minutes to complete it, so it is great to use when we have indoor recess. The students learn very quickly that they do not want to be the high school dropout!" explained Emily Johnson, Third Grade teacher at Bradie Shrum. "The game also teaches math skills and the basics of budgeting money."
