Have you ever wondered why kids would volunteer to give back, especially when the meetings are on Sundays? Well, let's hear from our 2017-2018 officers:

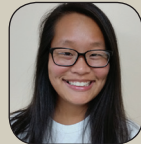

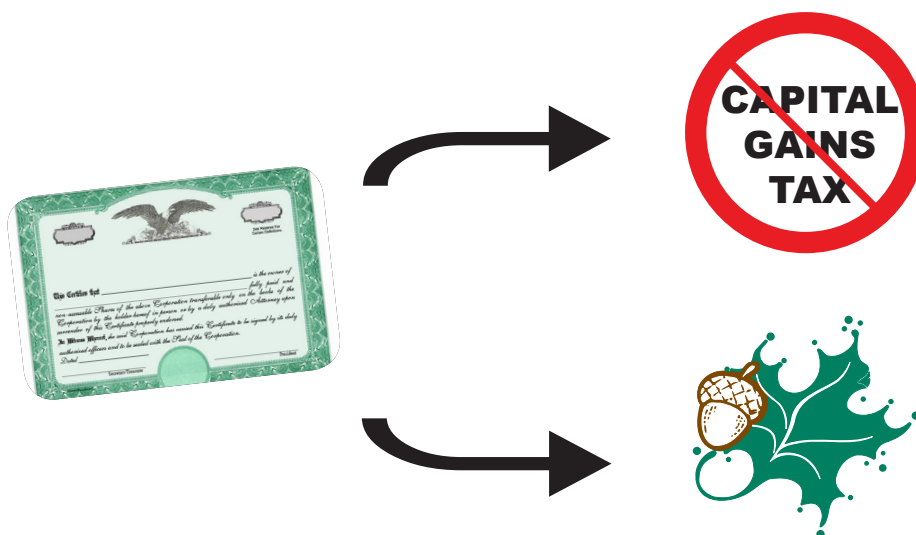
